Maplewood Chess Club – Spring 2010

2008 U.S. Chess Champion, Grandmaster Yury Shulman, is continuing the Maplewood 2009 Chess Program. The K - 4 program will run for 7 sessions after school at Maplewood School on Tuesdays from 3:20 to 4:30 PM.

Students will be engaged in learning chess, leadership programs, researching and presenting on history and geography related to chess, organizing tournaments, and serving the local community.

Chess students will have an opportunity to be featured periodically in local and national newspapers.

The club fee is \$ 84.00 and meets 7 times on Tuesdays 3:20 till 4:30 PM on the following dates:

April 6, 13, 20 27, May 4, 11, 18

Parents are welcome to help and learn with their child. *A 30% tuition discount is available (for a total of \$59) on a limited, first-come basis, for students having a parent volunteer able to help out for the entire session.*

Structure and Credentials: Players are split into two sections. Each section has an instructor.

- o Half the students receive instruction, the other half participates in supervised play, then the two groups switch.
- o The material covered in lessons as well as homework will be taken from the 2nd edition of the book **“Chess! Lessons from a Grandmaster”**. It is available in class. The price for our students is \$23, including tax and a 15% discount. After reading and submitting all of the Homework from the book and volunteering requirements, students may achieve a Chess Coach Certification.
